ASCII / American Standard Code for Information Interchange

ASCII is the standard code used for information interchange and communication between data processing systems, including Internet.

The **ASCII character set** (or **ASCII table**) initially contained 128 7-bit coded characters including alphabetic, numeric, control and graphic characters.

It has since been extended to include system and country specific characters.
